Event Details

- All booth set up must be completed by 2:00 p.m.
- This event will be open to VIP attendees at 3:00 p.m. and will end at 8:00 p.m.
- Winery/Cider ("Winery") staff is required to pour their own product. You are encouraged to have one of your representatives around your area as much as possible, to talk about your beer or brewery with Festival guests and distribute information regarding your beers (flyers, coasters, table tents, etc.)
- We highly recommend that discount cards or other incentives to attract Festival guests to your brewery be added to the swag bags that will be handed out at the event
- The Marc Jr Foundation will provide ice as needed throughout the day
- Winners announced and prizes presented at 8:30 p.m.

People Choice Award Judging

New this year to the festival is the inclusion of a People's Choice Competition. Each winery in attendance will be allowed to submit one (1) wine/cider to be judged by festivalgoers. To ensure your application - Wine/Cider - is in the running for the **People's Choice Award Applications** must be submitted and accepted by September 6, 2019.

Judging coins will be provided to each donating participant. The judging will be based on appearance, smell, and overall impression of the beer BUT it will come down to judging based on the best overall taste. Prizes are awarded to the winner, at the event, on the podium at 8:30 PM and you must be present to win.

Ticket Sales and Pours

Tickets are for sale to the public. Each ticket will entitle that guest to sampling from **3:00 pm to 8:00 pm**. All wine/cider samples will be poured in a quantity of 2 oz. Attendees will be given an imprinted sample glass. This is the **ONLY** container wine/cider may be poured into. Remember that the 2 oz. pour rule applies to wine/cider you and your representatives pour for yourselves. The Festival attendees will pay a one-time Festival fee, which will get them a wrist band (indicating that they are 21 years of age or older and have paid) and a Festival tasting glass for as many 2 oz. samples as they can responsibly consume. There will also be an opportunity for sales of individual

wines and/or ciders. There will be a trained crew of Festival staff and volunteers located throughout the Festival to handle every wine festival activity. There will also be live entertainment, and of course, plenty of food.

Exhibitor Space

- Exhibitors may use their space to display banners, promotional material, etc.
- Please note that bottled product will be poured into the consumers tasting glass before it leaves your area.
- We will be requesting notes on wines/ciders that will be tasted and wines/ciders that will be for sale to list in our program, including a brief description of products, with price range.

Festival

Wineries will be responsible for arranging transportation for their wine/cider. Wine/Cider may not be brought onto festival grounds until 9:00 am on September 21, 2019 and must be removed by 10:00 pm September 21, 2019. If you have any questions about the formalities of providing your product to the Festival, please contact the festival director.

What to Bring

- A way to dispense your wine/cider.
- Feel free to bring any banners you have with your branding, any other type of back drop, or signage to describe or identify the wines/ciders you will be pouring.
- We recommend that you provide incentives to attract Festival guests to your brewery.

Winery Representation

Each participating winery will be given two (2) VIP passes for staff at the Festival that can be exchanged among winery staff and representatives as needed. Additional passes can be obtained for \$20 each. All winery representatives must be at least 21 years of age. All winery representatives will be required to show proof of age before being issued their pass.

Winery representatives will be expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate and professional manner at all times during the Festival. Any activity on behalf of a winery or winery representative(s), which contradicts Colorado state law, may be subject to ejection at the discretion of the Festival Director.
